1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to J105, CFJ, Vanguard 15, Sabot A, B, C1, C2 and C3 boats.
- 2.2 Skippers must be members in good standing with their respective yacht clubs and class associations to be eligible to sail in this event.
- 2.3 Completed entry forms must be filed with Newport Harbor Yacht Club before the Competitors' Meeting on September 18, 2004. *Advanced registration is greatly appreciated.*
- 2.4 A representative from each boat must check-in with the Regatta Office at Newport Harbor Yacht Club on Saturday, September 18, 2004 between 0830-1030 hrs.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available upon Check In at the Newport Harbor Yacht Club.

5. COMPETITORS' MEETING

- 5.1 A competitors' meeting will be held at NHYC on Saturday, September 18 at 0930 hrs on the Flag Deck for all ocean racing classes.
- 5.2 A competitors' meeting will be held at NHYC on Saturday, September 18 at 1100 on the Flag Deck for all classes racing in the Newport Bay.

6. RACING AREA

- 6.1 Vanguard 15, Sabot A, B, C1, and C2 boats will be racing in the harbor north of the Main Dock of the Newport Harbor Yacht Club.
- 6.2 Sabot C3 boats will be racing in the Lido Channel.
- 6.3 The CFJ class will race approximately 0.5 miles west of the Balboa Pier.
- 6.4 The J105 class will race approximately 1.0 miles west of the Newport Pier.

7. SHORESIDE ANNOUNCEMENTS

- 7.1 Notices to Competitors, including changes to the Sailing Instructions and or the Schedule of Races, will be posted on the Official Notice Board located on the Main Deck of NHYC.
- 7.2 Signals made ashore for the ocean courses will be displayed from the mast of the race committee vessel, *Jim Webster*.
- 7.3 Signals made ashore for the bay courses will be displayed from the mast of the race committee vessel, *Dick Sweet*.

8. SCORING

- 8.1 The Low-Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply.
- 8.2 Six (6) races are scheduled of which two (2) shall be completed to constitute a series.
- 8.3 If five (5) or fewer races are completed, a boat's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races.
- 8.4 If six (6) or more races are completed, a boat's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races, with her worst score discarded.

9. TROPHIES

- 9.1 Trophies will be awarded Sunday, September 19, 2004 as soon as possible after the last race.
- 9.2 The Winner of the J105 Fleet will be awarded the Don Bever Memorial Trophy.
- 9.3 The winner of the CFJ class will be awarded the SCYYRA Commodore's Cup Perpetual Trophy.

PARKING

The NHYC parking lot is for members only. Regatta participant parking passes will be issued at registration to visiting competitors. Cars without member stickers, or regatta permits are subject to towing. Street parking is available. Please be aware that trailers parked on the street must be attached to a car.
