

2004-5 North Series Regatta #1
Alamitos Bay Yacht Club
Notice Of Race
October 2-3, 2004

Rules: This regatta is governed by the "rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.

Eligibility, Entry, Entry Fee: This regatta is open to all Junior Sabot INSA members in A, B, C1, C2 and C3 fleets. Entry fee is \$15.00 per boat payable to ABYC. North Series eligibility is defined in the SCYYRA Handbook. Five entries are required to establish a class. If a class does not have the required number of entries it may be combined with another class. Each competitor must complete an Entry Form & Release of Liability signed by a parent or guardian.

A separate North Series entry must be filed by 1030, Saturday Oct. 2, 2004. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the race committee. Entries for subsequent legs of the North Series may be accepted at other host sites. See www.scyyra.org for a North Series Notice of Race and Entry Form.

Schedule of Events: On Saturday, October 2th, registration will be open between 0900-1030 and the skippers meeting will be held on the patio at ABYC at 1030. The First Warning signal for both days will be at 1130. Subsequent races will be started as soon as practicable after race one each day. A Lunch Break will be at discretion of race committee.

Notice to Competitors: Notice to competitors will be posted on the ABYC Official Notice Board located outside the Entry Room.

Sailing Instructions: Available at registration.

Number of Races, Scoring: Seven races are scheduled. One race constitutes a series. Low point-scoring system per Appendix A. However Appendix A is modified as follows: each boats score shall be the total of her race scores.

North Series Competitors: North Series competitors will sail in A fleet only. 2004-5 series competitors must have entered at ABYC. Their scores will be carried forward.

Awards: Awards will be presented after last race. There will be five trophies for the Sabot A Class. For the all other classes trophies will be awarded as follows; 5 boats – 1 trophy, 6 to 8 boats – 2 trophies, 9 to 11 boats - 3 trophies, 12 to 14 boats – 4 trophies, 15 or greater – 5 trophies.

Parking and Storage: Due to space limitations, parking on ABYC grounds is restricted. Off-street parking is available across the street in municipal lots - participants should obtain passes from the ABYC office or a representative in the parking lots. Participants may bring their boats into the ABYC yard on the Friday before the regatta between 0900 and 1700. Storage beyond Monday Oct. 4th must be arranged, on a space-available basis, IN ADVANCE by contacting the ABYC office.

Coaching: Only properly registered competitors, Race Committee and event supplied spectator and coach boats will be allowed inside the racing area. Anyone wishing to bring additional coach boats must contact Mike Segerblom (mikesego@collegesailing.org or 562-433-7939) in advance for permission and arrangements. Power boats will not be allowed to launch at ABYC on Saturday or Sunday.

Hospitality: The hospitality of ABYC is extended to all participants. The ABYC Galley will be open from 0900 to 1630 each racing day; breakfast will be served from 0900 to 1030, and bag lunches will be available from the Galley.
