The 2005-2006 SCYYRA Shadden Series #2 for CFJ class boats will be hosted by California Yacht Club (CYC) on Sunday, October 9. CYC is located at 4469 Admiralty Way, Marina del Rey, CA 90292, phone 310.823.4567. Information about CYC and this regatta is available at www.calyachtclub.com.

1. Rules.

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the "**rules**" as defined in the 2005-2008 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). RRS 40 is changed to apply at all times while on the water, except when temporarily adding or removing clothing between races, regardless of whether or not code flag "Y" is flown. The SCYYRA 2005-2006 Shadden Perpetual Trophy Series Notice of Race will apply.
- 1.2 RRS 75.3 does not apply.

3. Eligibility and Entry.

- 3.1 This series is open to CFJ class boats. Each participant must (1) be under 21 years of age during the series and (2) be a member of a SCYA or SCYYRA yacht club. Either the skipper or crew must be a member in good standing of the CFJ Class Association.
- 3.2 Each entrant must submit a completed CYC Entry Form, **signed by a parent or guardian**, to the Race Committee before the start of the Competitors' Meeting at 0930 hours on Sunday, October 9. Late entries will be accepted only with the prior approval of the Regatta Chairman.

9. **Sailing Instructions.** The Sailing Instructions will be available at the CYC front desk beginning Saturday, October 8 and may also be posted at www.calyachtclub.com.

10. **Venue.** The racing area will be on Santa Monica Bay approximately one (1) nautical mile northwest of the entrance to Marina del Rey.

11. **The Courses.** Courses will be primarily windward / leeward with some reaching legs if conditions warrant.

13. **Scoring.** The Low Point System of RRS Appendix A will apply except that all races will count. Two (2) races must be completed to constitute a regatta.

14. **Tows / Support Boats.** Courtesy tows to the racing area will be available in the vicinity of the launch area; however, it is the responsibility of each competitor to be at the start on time.

19. Prizes. Prizes will be awarded at CYC as soon as possible after racing.

20. Disclaimer of Liability. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers (organizing authority, host yacht club, race committee, protest committee, sponsors, and any others acting in an official capacity for this event) from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

RACE ENTRY AGREEMENT - Please Read Carefully 10/23/98

In consideration of acceptance of my entry by California Yacht Club ("CYC"), I acknowledge and agree as follows:

1. I own or have chartered the boat entered and I am a member of a yacht club or sailing association that belongs to USSA. My boat will be equipped to conform with USCG, USSA and Class/Fleet safety requirements.

2. I am personally responsible for the operation of my boat and will comply with the rules of the ISAF as adopted by the USSA, and with all laws, rules and sailing instructions governing the race and use of the marina, including Cal. Harbors & Navigation Code.

3. CYC is not my insurer. I will maintain sufficient insurance to protect from all risks arising from this Agreement.

4. **ASSUMPTION OF RISK.** THERE ARE RISKS INHERENT IN THE SPORT OF YACHT RACING, AND I FREELY ASSUME ALL RISKS, INCLUDING PERSONAL INJURY OR DEATH TO MYSELF AND MY CREW, LOSS OR DAMAGE TO MY YACHT AND ITS

EQUIPMENT, AS WELL AS UNFORESEEN RISKS.

5. **WAIVER, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION.** TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, I WAIVE ALL CLAIMS, FOREVER RELEASE AND AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS CYC, IT'S OWNERS, AFFILIATES, OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES, AGENTS, COMMITTEE PERSONS AND RACE OFFICIALS ACTING IN THEIR OFFICIAL CAPACITIES, FROM ANY DAMAGE, LIABILITY, LOSS, COST OR EXPENSE INCLUDING ATTORNEY FEES, ARISING FROM MY AND MY CREW'S PARTICIPATION IN THE RACE, INCLUDING CYC'S ACTIVE OR PASSIVE REGULAR NEGLIGENCE, BUT NOT CYC'S WILLFUL MISCONDUCT OR GROSS NEGLIGENCE.
