1 RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the 2005-2008 Racing Rules of Sailing and the prescriptions of US SAILING.
- 1.2. The rules of the C420 Class, the Perry Series Standing Rules as published in the 2006 SCYYRA Year Book and the 2006-07 Perry Perpetual Trophy Series Notice of Race, the Notice of Race published for this event (except where modified by the Sailing Instructions) and the Sailing Instructions will also apply.
- 1.3. RRS 35, 40.1, 44.1, 44.2, 75.3 and Race Signals will be changed. The changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. This regatta is open to C420 Class boats that meet the following requirements:
 - a. The skipper and crew shall be under 21 years of age.
 - b. The skipper and crew shall be members of an SCYA or SCYYRA recognized yacht club.
 - c. The skipper and crew shall be members of US SAILING.
 - d. Skippers must be a member in good standing of the C420 Class.
- 2.2. A completed SDYC Entry Form with signature of the skipper and a parent or guardian must be submitted to the SDYC Junior Office by 0945 on Saturday, November 11, 2006 along with a \$35.00 entry fee.
- 2.3. Boats not already registered in the Perry Series may compete in this regatta, but will need to register to compete in the Perry Series as well.

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 4.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available at check in on November 11, 2006.

5 RACING

- 5.1. The racing area will be approximately 1 NM southeast of Zuniga Jetty in the area known as the Coronado Roads.
- 5.2. Sailors should be prepared for a long day on the water.
- 5.3. Nutrition bars, water, and fruit will be provided for all competitors. Competitors are advised to bring additional water/sports drinks as it will be a long day on the water.
- 5.4. All boats must have a bowline of at least 25 feet for towing purposes.

6 COURSES

6.1. The courses to be sailed will be as follows: triangle, windward-leeward or any combination thereof.

7 PENALTY SYSTEM

7.1. RRS 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe is required.

8 SCORING

8.1. This regatta will be scored as provided in RRS Appendix A using the Low Point System. Two races will constitute a regatta.

9 SUPPORT/SPECTATOR BOATS

9.1. Spectator boats will not be provided.

9.2. Team leaders, coaches and other support personnel shall stay outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the preparatory signal until all boats have finished the race or the race committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment.

10 TRAILERS

10.1. All trailers should be stored in the lot adjacent to the tennis courts; any trailer parked along the side fence may be moved or towed at the discretion of the dockmaster.

10.2. Competitors must provide their own dollies and all boats must be clear of the fire lanes.

10.3. Support boats will be berthed in the whaler slip adjacent to the Jr. Dock. No boats may be tied up in private slips.

11 TROPHIES

11.1. Trophies will be awarded to the skipper and crew of the top three teams at the regatta.

12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

12.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13 HOSPITALITY

13.1. Lunch is provided for all competitors.

13.2. There will be a trophy snack for Shadden competitors after racing.

13.3. Guests may register with the SDYC front desk for a guest card. The dining room and bar will open at 1100.
