

# Applications for the 2010 SCYYRA Sailing Team are here!

The Southern California Youth Yacht Racing Association sponsors a program to recognize advanced junior sailors from Southern California who have shown tremendous dedication and accomplishment in youth sailing.

Each year a select number of the top junior sailors from San Diego to Santa Barbara are chosen to become members of the annual SCYYRA Sailing Team and invited to participate in advance sailing clinics and otherwise be recognized.

Selection of this year's team will be based on regatta results between September 1<sup>st</sup> 2008 and August 31<sup>st</sup> 2009, as well as age, ability, sportsmanship and geographic location.

All Southern California sailors that have placed well in Local, Regional, National and International regattas are encouraged to complete an application for consideration onto this year's team.

Attached is an official application which encourages local sailors to review their past 12 months racing resume' and submit an entry. Applications are due by October 15<sup>th</sup>, 2009.

On the reverse side of this form is a copy of the "Selection Matrix" that will be used to help select this year's elite team of sailors. As you can see, the most competitive regattas that you have sailed throughout the year are those that you should include on your application, as only your top 5 regattas are considered when totaling points.

The Southern California Youth Yacht Racing Association Officers and Directors look forward to reviewing your application to become a member of the upcoming 2010 SCYYRA Sailing Team!

The 2010 SCYYRA Sailing Team will be announced following the SCYYRA Annual Meeting on November 7, 2009.
