1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US SAILING, the rules of the CFJ Class, except as any of these are altered by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. Races will be umpired. Rule D2.3(b), Races with Limited Umpiring, shall apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. There will be a limit of 12 teams accepted on a first come, first served basis. No organization may enter more than two teams and the host reserves the right to decide on organizational affiliation.
- 2.2. The regatta will be sailed in CFJs. 24 boats will be utilized and each team must supply two boats for the regatta.
- 2.3. Teams may enter by completing the online entry at www.sdyc.org/juniors. Registration will open on December 27, 2011.
- 2.4. Each team will consist of three boats, including three skippers and three crews in order to qualify for entry into the regatta. Substitutions will only be allowed at the discretion of the Principle Race Officer.

3. FEES

- 3.1. Entry fee is \$60 per team.
- 3.2. Each team must also supply a \$250 damage deposit in the form of a check prior to the close of regatta registration.

- 4.2. The regatta format and the number of races will be determined by the Principle Race Officer and will be based on the number of teams registered and the weather conditions. Possible formats include but are not limited to: Round Robin, Split Fleet Round Robin, and Elimination Ladder, followed by quarterfinals, semifinals, and finals. The format to be attempted, contingency formats (if any) and changes to the format will be posted on the Official Notice Board.

6. VENUE

- 6.1. The racing area will be in the basin between San Diego and Southwestern Yacht Clubs. Rotations will be off the SDYC Race Dock (E) and viewing is available from the docks and shore.

7. COURSES

- 7.1. The course will be any variation of the N-course.

8. EQUIPMENT

- 8.1. Club Flying Juniors will be sailed. Each team must supply two CFJs in good working order. All boats will be added to the rotational fleet.
- 8.2. Sails will be provided and a \$10 maintenance fee per each set of sails is included in the overall entry fee.
- 8.3. Boats will be inspected prior to the first race as part of a teams' entry.
- 8.4. Standing rigging shall not be adjusted without prior permission of the Regatta Chairmen and, if applicable, the Chief Umpire/Judge.
- 8.5. Competitors will be responsible for damage to boats as a result of a foul or negligence.

9. AWARDS

- 9.1. The winning team will receive the SCYA Harold Adams Team Race Perpetual. Top three teams will receive awards.

10. ACCOMMODATIONS
