NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in current Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. The rules of the INSA Class, the North Series Standing Rules as published in the 2017 SCYYRA Year Book and the 2017-2018 North Perpetual Trophy Series Notice of Race, the Notice of Race published for this event (except where modified by the Sailing Instructions) will apply.
- 1.3. The INSA Gross Weight Rule will apply for all "A", "B", "C1" and "Senior" skippers; no other class weight rules will be enforced.

2 ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

- 2.1. This regatta is open to INSA Class boats that meet the following requirements:
 - 2.1.1. The skipper shall be a member of an SCYA or SCYYRA recognized yacht club.
 - 2.1.2. Skippers must be a member in good standing of the INSA Class.
- 2.2. The entry fee for the regatta will be \$40, which includes a t-shirt, lunches, and trophies. Entries received after 1600PST September 22, 2016 shall be subject to a \$10 late fee and desired shirt size may not be guaranteed.
- 2.3. Eligible boats may enter by registering online at www.sdyc.org/juniors.
- 2.4. This regatta is open to Sabots racing in the following fleets: Junior A, B, C1, C2, C3, and Senior Sabot.

3 NORTH SERIES COMPETITORS

- 3.1. North Series competitors will sail in A fleet only. All A Fleet sailors are encouraged to register for the North Series, via the SCYYRA website.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1. Sailing Instructions will be available at Check-In.

6 VENUE

- 6.1. The intended course area for all Sabot fleets will be the basin to the south of the San Diego Yacht Club, aka "La Playa."

7 THE COURSES

- 7.1. A course chart will be provided in the sailing instructions.

8 RACES

- 8.1. Races will be started in accordance with RRS Appendix U (full whistle sequence).
- 8.2. A maximum of 10 races shall be sailed.

9 SCORING

- 9.1. The Low Point System of Appendix A shall apply as modified by 10.2.
- 9.2. Two races must be completed to constitute a series. Only after six or more races are completed, shall a boat's worst score will be excluded from her series' score.

10 COACH BOATS

- 10.1. Coaching is not allowed while competitors are racing, except in the C3 division for competitors who are substantially behind the fleet.

11 TROPHIES

- 11.1. Trophies will be presented to the top competitors in each fleet.

12 HOSPITALITY

- 12.1. Lunch will be provided both days, as well as a snack during trophy presentation.
