- 1) **VENUE:** The **29ers Midwinter West Regatta** is sailed on the waters of South San Diego Bay, an area recognized for its superb racing conditions. The race committee will run as many races as possible! Races will be windward/leeward courses.
  
- 2) **RULES**
  - 2.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing and the current 29er Class Rules.
  - 2.2 All competitors shall wear a proper size/fit US Coast Guard Approved PFD while afloat. Compliance may be monitored by random inspections on the water by RC personnel. Those found breaking this rule may be protested.
  
- 3) **ELIGIBILITY:** Entries are limited to Class legal 29er's. Skippers must be members in good standing in yacht clubs or organizations recognized by US Sailing, SCYA, SDAYC or similar organization. Both skipper and crew must be current members of the 29er Class Association.
  
- 4) **ENTRY:** Eligible boats intending to race shall register on regatta toolbox
  
- 5) **REGISTRATION / CHECK-IN:** The skipper or a representative must check-in between 10:30-12:00 on Friday March 23rd. Registration will be located by "Port Side" Lounge area at CYC.
  
- 6) **FEES:**

\$100 entry fee per boat for teams registered prior to midnight PST Friday, March 9<sup>th</sup>.\*

\$150 entry fee per boat for teams registered on or after Saturday, March 10<sup>th</sup>.\*

Entry closes on Thursday, March 22nd at 1200. Register online on at regatta toolbox

Entry fee includes post-racing snacks Friday-Sunday, regatta t-shirts and awards.

\*teams not registered before March 10th are not guaranteed shirts.

**12) SCORING**

12.1 The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A2, shall be used except as modified below.

12.2 A minimum of 3 races must be completed to constitute a regatta.

12.3 When fewer than five (5) races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
