NOTICE OF RACE
SUNDAY, JUNE 10, 2018



1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), and by the INSA class rules. Any changes will be addressed in the Competitors Meeting and/or the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 All Sabot A, B and C1 entries must abide by INSA class rule, Section 8.A.1 in INSA year book: For Junior Championship regattas and all Junior A, B and C1 regattas (excluding Sabot II), the gross weight of the skipper plus hull and equipment, as defined in specifications, must equal 220 pounds
- 1.3 USCG approved PFD's shall be worn at all times by competitors while on the water, other than brief periods, while adding or removing clothing. The 'Y' flag will not be flown. This modifies RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4.

2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to Sabot C3-A.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by submitting an entry form and paying the entry fee at www.liyc.net by 4:00pm one day prior to the event to avoid a late fee. All entries received AFTER 4:00pm, Saturday, June 9 will be subject to a \$10 late fee. In-person, day-of registration will be accepted. All entry fees are nonrefundable.

3. ENTRY FEE

\$15 Sabots

(\$10 Late fee for all day-of entries, online registration closes 4:00pm 06/9/2018)

4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 4.1 Check –In: Competitors may check in Sunday, June 10, and registrations will be accepted, in person, at LIYC, until 10:30am on June 10. Course charts and SI's will be online and available at LIYC registration desk.

Competitor's Meeting – 11:30am

First Warning Signal – All Classes - 12:00pm

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1 Sailing Instructions will be posted at www.liyc.net on June 9 after 6pm. SI's will also be available at LIYC registration desk.

6. VENUE AND COURSES

- 6.1 Boat launching: Coach Boats may be launched at Genoa West (please contact Sailing Director for more information).
- 6.2 Racing will take place in the Lido Channel or in the Newport Harbor Turning Basin. Street parking is available; please do not park in front of garages or in red zones.
- 6.3 Courses will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

7. FORMAT & SCORING

- 7.1 The low point system appendix A of the RRS.
- 7.2 The regatta format will be determined June 9 and posted on www.liyc.net. It will be based on the number of entries in each fleet and the weather conditions.
- 7.3 Two (2) races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 7.4 When five (5) or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

8. TROPHIES

- 8.1 Trophies will be awarded as soon as possible after racing.

9. DISCLAIMER

- 9.1 Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage or injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
