2. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY & ENTRY FEE

2.1. The Series is open to junior sailors under the age of 19 and who have not yet entered college. To be eligible for the SCYYRA Ullman/Frost Series Perpetual Trophies participants must be members of a current SCYYRA organization.

2.2 Entries for the 2018/2019 Ullman and Frost Series must be filed online using Regatta Toolbox (RT).

2.2.1 All Ullman / Frost regatta participants must enter in the Ullman / Frost series. The registration tool for the regatta will automatically check for Series membership, and enter the sailor in the Ullman / Frost Series if the sailor is not already registered for the series.

2.2.2 There will be a one time \$20 Series entry fee. In addition, \$5 from each regatta entry fee will go to the series. If you compete in at least 2 of the 4 regattas in the series, you will get a t-shirt. Using Regatta Toolbox please make sure that you are entered in the SCYYRA Ullman / Frost Series.

2.3. The current list of registrants will be posted on the SCYYRA website.

3. CLASS MEMBERSHIP

3.1. All skippers shall be a member in good standing of the International Laser Class Association North American Region.

3.2. Membership can be obtained on the Laser Class website at www.laser.org -click on "Join the Class". Junior class membership (under 18 years old) is approximately \$40. Please include your Laser Class membership number when completing your on line entry. Class membership information will be verified.

4. RULES

4.1. Each regatta will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of US SAILING, the Ullman/Frost Series Standing Rules as published on the SCYYRA Website; the Laser Class Rules; this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions issued by each club. See http://www.scyyra.org/ullman_frost/c/C18 for more info.

5. SCORING

5.1. The Low-Point Scoring System, rule A2, will apply with **20 or more** races scheduled. A DNC will be based on the total number of entries in the series. A DNF, DSQ and DNS will be based on the total number of Ullman/Frost Series starters in each individual regatta.

5.2. Throwout races will be incorporated into the series scoring with the following formulas:

☐ *If 14-15 races are completed, there will be 1 throwout*

☐ *If 16-17 races are completed, there will be 2 throwouts*

☐ *If 18-19 races are completed, there will be 3 throwouts*

☐ *If 20 or more races are completed, there will be 4 throwouts.*

5.3. Sail number and crew changes must be approved by the Ullman/Frost Series Chairman, John Long and reported to the race committee before the first race each day.

5.4. Races sailed on Fridays of three-day events will not be incorporated into the series scoring.
