

2018 SABOT II INVITATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP Bahia Corinthian Yacht Club NOTICE OF RACE

July 18, 2018



1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), by the INSA class rules, and by the INSA Conditions for the Sabot II Championships. Any changes will be addressed in the Competitors Meeting and/or the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 USCG approved PFD's shall be worn at all times by competitors while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing. The 'Y' flag will not be flown. This modifies RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4.

2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 2.1 Eligibility requirements for boats are they are a Naples Sabot.
- 2.2 Eligibility requirements for competitors are that they are eleven (11) years of age or younger (may not turn 12 on or after Tuesday July 10, 2018), and that they are a current member of INSA.
- 2.3 All online entries must be submitted by 5pm on Tuesday, July 17th. Visit http://naples-sabot.org to find the registration link. Walk-up entries will be accepted until the close of registration Wednesday, July 18th.

3. ENTRY FEE

3.1 \$20 (per boat)

4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

4.1 Mandatory Check –In: All competitors must check in Wednesday July 18th between 9:30am-10:30am.

4.2 Subsequent races will be started as soon as possible after race one. There will be no scheduled lunch break. Sailors should bring lunch on the water with them or in a support boat. No race will start after 1530.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Sailing Instructions will be provided during Check-In on the day of the event.

6. VENUE AND COURSES

- 6.1 Boat launching: Coach Boats may be launched from the crane located in the BCYC boatyard.
- 6.2 Racing will take place in the vicinity of the Turning Basin ("Five Points").
- 6.3 Courses may be windward-leeward or any variation of a triangular or other course. Course diagrams will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

7. WEIGHTS

7.1 Skipper weights are not required for a Sabot II Qualifier or Championship event.

8. SCORING

8.1 Scoring will be in accordance with the RRS Appendix A.

9. TROPHIES

9.1 Trophies will be awarded as soon as possible after the last race. Trophies will be awarded to the top 5 finishers.

10. DISCLAIMER

10.1 Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage or injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
