## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing. Racing rule(s) 4, 26, 35, 40, 44.1, 44.2, 61.2(d) and 61.3. will be changed. The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions.

### 2 ADVERTISING

This is a "Category A" event for advertising on Sabots (no advertising) and a Category C event for Lasers and Laser Radials.

### 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Naples Sabot, Laser, and Laser Radial class.

3.3 Fees: the registration fee shall be \$55 if the sailor has registered online by October 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018. If registering after October 31<sup>st</sup> the fee will be \$85. Fees cover two days of sailing, Saturday Beach Party, a trophy snack, T-shirt, and trophies.

4.2 There will be no lunch breaks ashore.

4.3 After racing Sunday, after race snacks will be provided

4.4 The trophy presentation will take place as soon as possible after the last race

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS The sailing instructions will be available on check-in at registration. Preliminary Sailing Instructions will be available on the Regatta Website on November 1<sup>st</sup>.

6 VENUE Sabot A, B, and C1 will take place in the Sail Bay portion of Mission Bay. Sabot C-3 and C-2 sailors will race in "Chicken Cove". Laser Radial and Laser Full fleets will race in the North part of Mission Bay.

7 THE COURSES The courses to be described in the Sailing Instructions.

8 PENALTY SYSTEM For all classes rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one jibe, is required.

9 SCORING The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply. Two races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

10 SUPPORT BOATS Support boats shall be prominently marked with the burgee of the appropriate club or sailing organization. Support boats shall be required to monitor the appropriate Race Committee VHF channel and respond as requested.

11 RADIO COMMUNICATION A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

14 PRIZES Prizes will be given as follows: the top five boats in each Sabot fleet and Laser Radial Fleet, top three for Laser Full Rig fleet. There will also be the SDAYC Laser and Radial Championship Perpetuals plus the Peg Greybill Sportsmanship award handed out during the awards ceremony.

15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
