1. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY, ENTRY FEE & AWARDS

- 1.1. The Series is open to junior sailors under the age of 19 and who have not yet entered college. To be eligible for the SCYYRA Perry Series Perpetual Trophy participants must be members of a current SCYYRA organization.
- 1.2. Competitors must enter both the individual regatta and the Perry Series. RegattaToolbox will be used to manage the Perry. When you register for a regatta in the series, you will be prompted to register for the series automatically.
 - 1.2.1. To enter the Perry Series, a competitor must register via www.scyyra.org. Competitors must enter the series before the start of the first race of the second regatta.
 - 1.2.2. Perry Regatta Registration www.scyyra.org
 - 1.2.3. All Perry regatta participants must enter in the Perry series. The registration tool for the regatta will automatically check for Perry Series membership, and enter the sailor in the Perry Series if the sailor is not already registered for the series.
 - 1.2.4. There will be a one time \$20 Perry Series entry fee. In addition \$10 from each regatta entry fee will go to the series. If you compete in at least 2 of the 4 regattas in the series, you will get a t-shirt. Using Regatta Toolbox please make sure that you are entered in both the SCYYRA Perry Series AND all regattas that you will compete in.
- 1.3. There will be a \$20 series entry fee payable online to SCYYRA. The Series entry fee includes T-shirts for each skipper and crew.
- 1.4. Trophies will be awarded to the top places in the Perry Series.

2. CLASS MEMBERSHIP

2.1. Competitors (skipper & crew) must be members in good standing of the Club 420 Class Association. Membership can be obtained on the Club 420 Class website at www.club420.org. Please include your Club 420 Class membership number when completing your online entry. Class membership information will be verified.



3. RULES

3.1. Each regatta will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020*, the prescriptions of US SAILING, the Perry Series Standing Rules as published on the SCYYRA website; the Club 420 Class Rules; this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions issued by each club.

4. SCORING

- 4.1. Perry Series scoring shall be based on the official results of each race tabulated only against other Perry Series entrants.
- 4.2. Perry Series scoring shall be in accordance with US Sailing Appendix A9 (2017-2020 RRS).
- 4.3. For the Perry Series a DNC is defined as not registering for a Perry Series Regatta and shall be scored the number of entries in the Perry Series plus one.
- 4.4. Ties will be broken using US SAILING Appendix A. If a tie still exists, the winner shall be the yacht ahead in the final race that the two participating yachts both started.
- 4.5. Throwout races will be incorporated into the series scoring with the following formulas:
 - a. If 14-15 races are completed, there will be 1 throwout
 - b. If 16-17 races are completed, there will be 2 throwouts
 - c. If 18-19 races are completed, there will be 3 throwouts
 - d. If 20 or more races are sailed, there will be 4 throwouts
- 4.6. Sail number changes must be reported to the Perry Series Chairman John Long and reported to the race committee before the first race each day.
