1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, including Appendix U.
- 1.2 USCG approved PFD's shall be worn at all times by competitors while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing. The 'Y' flag will not be flown. This changes RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4.
- 1.3 Sabot A, B, and C1 fleet boats may be subject to on-water equipment inspection upon the finish of each race. Refer to INSA class rules for a list of required equipment.
- 1.4 US Sailing Prescriptions 63.2 is deleted.

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all Junior Naples Sabot boats whose skipper is a member in good standing of INSA.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by submitting the entry form and paying the entry fee online www.nhyc.org, on or before Friday 6/25/21 by 5pm. An entry is not considered complete until the entry fee has been paid. All entry fees are non-refundable.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available at www.nhyc.org by 5:00pm Thursday June 24, 2021 and at check-in on Saturday morning.

5. RACING VENUE AND COURSES

- 5.1 Race Venue 1: Harbor north of the Main Dock of NHYC.
- 5.2 Race Venue 2: Lido Channel.
- 5.3 The course may be a windward - leeward or any variation of a triangular or other course. Course diagrams will be provided in the sailing instructions.

6. FORMAT & SCORING

- 6.1 The regatta format will be determined at the close of registration. It will be based on the number of entries in each fleet and the forecasted weather conditions. It is the intent of the race committee to sail fleets that exceed 36 entries in flights.
- 6.2 Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 6.3 When five (5) or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

7. DISCLAIMER

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
