NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by the *Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association (US Sailing) and the rules and By-Laws of the Club 420 Association.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to boats meeting the requirements of the Club 420 class rules.
- 2.2. All competitors (both skipper and crew) must be current members of the Club 420 Association.
- 2.3. All competitors must be current members of Southern California Youth Yacht Racing Association. Membership is free – Join here: <https://theclubspot.com/join/WiAmVdxMup/overview>
- 2.4. Individuals who will be twenty-three years or older in the calendar year are not eligible to compete in this regatta.
- 2.5. Registration will open for competitors on **14 August, 2023 at 1700 hours**. You may register by going to the following URL: <https://cbyc.org/regatta/IYA6vVvYXJ>
- 2.6. **A late fee will go into effect on 8 September at 2400 hours.**
- 2.7. All competitors must sign a “Release of Liability” using the online waiver process located on the event website to participate in the regatta. Those competitors under the age of 18 must have their “Release of Liability” form signed by a parent or guardian. **The Waiver Process is provided electronically when registering through Clubspot. If possible when registering, enter all skipper and crew information to make this process easier for you and the OA.**
- 2.8. No registration will be considered complete until all fees, required forms and signatures are received.
- 2.9. **THIS REGATTA HAS A MAXIMUM OF 70 BOATS. COMPLETED REGISTRATIONS (All fees paid, and waivers signed) WILL BE CONSIDERED REGISTERED. The OA and the Club 420 Class may choose to expand or contract the regatta’s size based on health and safety conditions. A decision on whether or not to expand beyond 70 boats will be made no later than September 6th.**

3. FEES

- 3.1. The entry fee per boat is \$150 if received on or before 8 September at 2400. This includes SCYYRA and C420 sanctioning fees that total \$50.
- 3.2. Entry fees are non-refundable on or after 11 September at 1800.
- 3.3. All refunds are subject to a reasonable administrative fee that covers the OA’s non-refundable credit card and electronic waiver fees.
- 3.4. A late fee of \$50 will be assessed for any entries received on or after 8 September at 2400.
- 3.5. Depending on COVID guidelines and to ensure the safety of our OA team and competitors and guests, the entry fee includes at a minimum, snacks after racing and regatta memorabilia.

11. COACH BOATS

- 11.1. All coach boats are considered safety boats and at the direction of the OA or race committee and will render aid if requested.

12. PRIZES

- 12.1. Prizes will be awarded to first place through 5th place.
12.2. The top placing Junior team in which both skipper and crew are **under 16** throughout 2023.

13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this regatta participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Ratings Authority, Race Committee, Protest Committee, Cabrillo Beach Yacht Club, sponsors, the Club 420 Association or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this regatta, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

14. OTHER REQUIREMENTS

- 14.1. If a competitor under the age of 18 is not accompanied by a parent or legal guardian during all activities of the regatta, then the parent or legal guardian shall name a "Designated Adult" of 18 years or older, through entry in the online registration process and shall be present at all times in their absence and who will supervise the minor competitor at all times to assure his/her safety. This Designated Adult will accept full responsibility for all actions of the competitor during any activity related to the event. This includes onshore activities before, during, and after the regatta.
- 14.2. For each competitor under 18, it is the competitor's parents, legal guardian or Designated Adult's decision to enter the regatta and to start or continue any race. The adult(s) supervising the competitors are ultimately responsible for the risks.
- 14.3. A competitor age 18 or older retains all responsibilities for himself or herself.
- 14.4. No contestant shall use, either on or off the water, alcoholic beverages (beer, wine or distilled spirits) or use any controlled substance (marijuana, cocaine, etc.) the possession of which is unlawful. This prohibition is in effect during the entire event, from date and time of arrival through date and time of departure from the Cabrillo Beach YC. Penalties for a violation of the prohibition may range from a reprimand to dismissal from the regatta. A hearing may be held in accordance with the RRS.

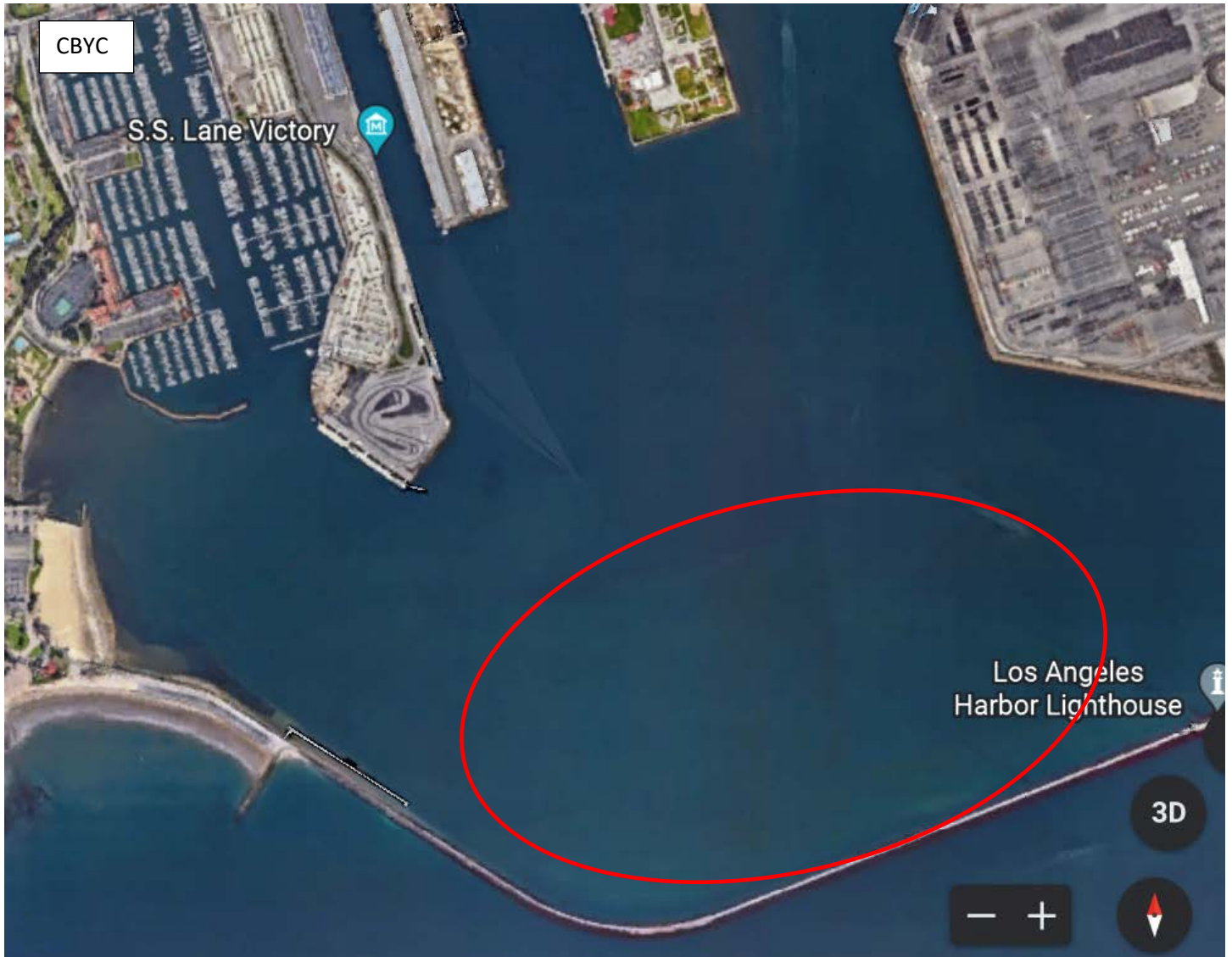

ATTACHMENT A – AERIAL VIEW OF RACING AREA



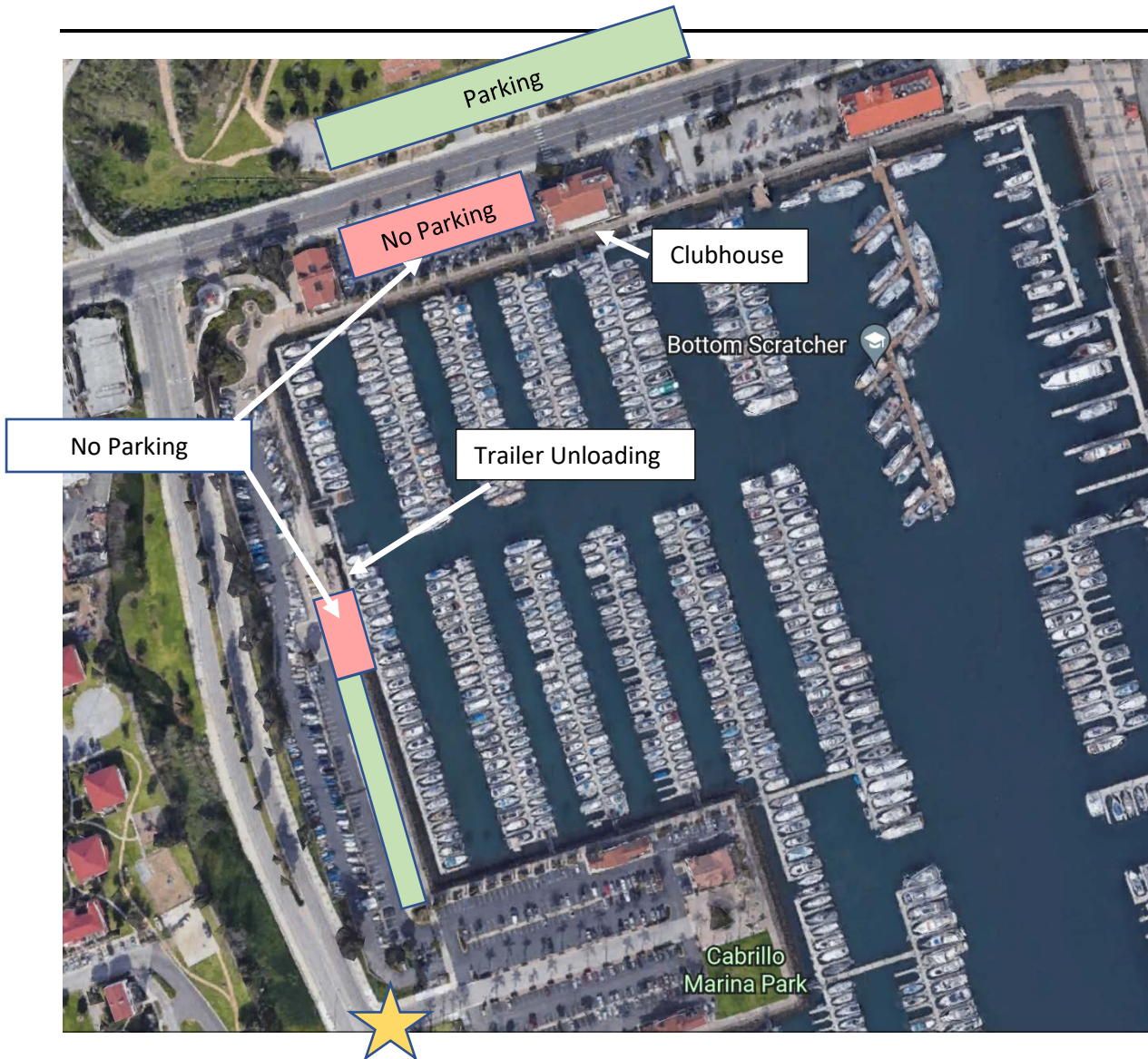
