NOTICE OF RACE

The Organizing Authority (OA) is Bahia Corinthian Yacht Club (BCYC). BCYC is located at 1601 Bayside Dr, Newport Beach, CA 92625. Phone number is (949) 683 - 5497. Club and Event information are available at www.bcytc.org.

1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), by the International Naples Sabot Association (INSA) class rules, and by the INSA Conditions for the Sabot II Championships. Any changes will be addressed in the Competitors Meeting and/or the Sailing Instructions.

1.2 USCG approved PFDs shall be worn at all times by competitors while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing. The 'Y' flag will not be flown. This modifies RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4.

1.3 Sabot A, Sabot B, and Sabot C1 fleet boats are required to carry weights if under the minimum weight requirement and may be subject to on-water equipment inspection upon the finish of each race. Refer to INSA class rules for a list of required equipment.

2 ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

2.1 This event is open to the Naples Sabot class.

2.2 All entries must be submitted on or before Friday, October 11. There will be a late fee of \$15 beginning 2359 on Wednesday, 10/02/2024.

3 ENTRY FEE

3.1 \$40 per boat

3.2 \$15 late fee for all entries received after 2359 on Wednesday, 10/02/2024.

4 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

4.1 Mandatory check-in: All competitors must check in on Saturday, October 12 between 9:30am-10:30am.

4.2 Subsequent races will be started as soon as possible after the previous race. There will be no scheduled lunch break.

4.3 BCYC will be hosting an ice cream social on our pool deck and lower patio immediately following racing on Saturday Oct. 12. We highly encourage all sailors and parents to stay and enjoy the evening with us!

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Sailing Instructions will be available online on or before Saturday 10/12/24 and upon Check In at BCYC.

6. RACING VENUE AND COURSES

6.1 Sabots A/B/C1 will sail in the vicinity of "Five Points" (Turning Basin)

6.2 Sabot C2 & Sabot C3 classes will sail a separate course with a separate signal boat in the South Lido Channel or at the 'M Mark' area

6.3 Courses may be a windward/leeward, Triangle, or any variation of a trapezoid course. Course diagrams will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

7. SCORING

7.1 Three (3) races must be completed to constitute a series.

7.2 When five (5) or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of his/her race scores. This changes RRS A2.1

7.3 The Corinthian Cup perpetual trophy will be awarded to the yacht club with the best combined participation and overall high point score. High point performance calculation will include only the top five finishers per fleet in all classes and races.

8. DISCLAIMER

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage or injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
