**NOTICE OF RACE**  
**July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2024**



**1. RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), by the INSA class rules, and by the INSA Conditions for the Sabot II Championships. Any changes will be addressed in the Sailing Instructions and/or via email notice.
- 1.2 USCG approved PFD's shall be worn at all times by competitors while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing. The 'Y' flag will not be flown. This modifies RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4.

**2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY**

- 2.1 Eligibility requirements for boats are they are a Naples Sabot.
- 2.2 Eligibility requirements for competitors are that they are eleven (11) years of age or younger (may not turn 12 on or before Wednesday, July 10, 2024), and that they are a current members of INSA.
- 2.3 All online entries must be submitted by 5pm on Monday, July 8<sup>th</sup>. Visit [www.liyc.net](http://www.liyc.net) to find the registration link under Regattas.

**3. ENTRY FEE**

- 3.1 \$25 per boat
- 3.2 \$20 late fee for all entries received after 5pm on Friday, July 5<sup>th</sup>.

Subsequent races will be started as soon as possible after race one. There will be no scheduled lunch break if sailing in flights. Sailors should eat either before the start or during their "Bye Race." If flights are not needed, or there is no "Bye Race" there will be a brief on the water lunch break. No races will start after 1530.

**5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 5.1 Sailing Instructions will be posted on the Clubspot event page (can be found via [www.liyc.net](http://www.liyc.net)) on or before Tuesday, July 9th.

**6. VENUE AND COURSES**

- 6.1 Racing will take place in the Turning Basin/Five Points east of the Lido dock.
- 6.2 Courses may be windward-leeward or any variation of a triangular or other course. Course diagrams will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

6.3 If needed, boats will be divided into flights by the Organizing Authority. All boats must display their flight color ribbon from either the clew of their mainsail or the end of their boom.

**7. WEIGHTS**

7.1 Skipper weights are not required for a Sabot II Qualifier or Championship event.

**8. TROPHIES**

8.1 Trophies will be awarded as soon as possible after the last race. Trophies will be awarded to the top ten (10) finishers and to the youngest skipper who completes all of the races.

**9. DISCLAIMER**

9.1 Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage or injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury or illness to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
