## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2. RRS 40 is changed to require that each competitor wear a USCG-approved life jacket that is 100% dependent on foam for flotation and the appropriate size for the sailor, at all times while on the water, except for brief periods while adding or removing clothing. This modifies RRS 40.1, 40.2 and the preamble to Part 4.
- 1.3. Corrector weights are not required for the Sabot II Qualifier or Championship event, per [INSA Class Rules](#).

### 2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1. Competitors meeting the following criteria are eligible to compete in the Sabot II South Championship:
  - 2.1.1. Competitors must be eleven (11) years of age or younger and may not turn 12 on or before Thursday July 11, 2024.
  - 2.1.2. Competitors must be current members of the INSA class.

### 3. ENTRY AND FEES

- 3.1. Registration for eligible competitors is available online at <https://theclubspot.com/regatta/u7VMo2jV3l>.
- 3.2. The entry fee is \$25 per boat. Entries received after July 8, 2024, at 1200 PDT will pay an additional \$20 late registration fee.
- 3.3. No entries will be accepted after July 11, 2024, at 0930 PDT.

### 4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1. Competitors are required to check in at the Dockside Room in the Mailin Burnham Sailing Center before 1030 PDT.

### 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1. Sailing Instructions will be provided at check-in and online.

## **6. VENUE AND COURSES**

- 6.1. The intended racing venue shall be the La Playa Public Anchorage.
- 6.2. Courses will be windward-leeward, triangle, or a combination thereof. Course diagrams will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.
- 6.3. Boats may be divided into flights by the Organizing Authority. All boats must display their flight color ribbon from either the clew of their mainsail or the end of their boom.

## **7. SCORING**

- 7.1. Three races must be completed to constitute a series.
- 7.2. When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 7.3. When five or more races have been completed, each boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. This modifies RRS Appendix A.

## **8. PRIZES**

- 8.1. Trophies will be awarded to the top 10 (SOUTH) finishers, who will qualify for the Sabot II Invitational Championship Regatta.

## **9. DISCLAIMER**

- 9.1. Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage or injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
