NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, including Appendix U.
- 1.2 The organizing authority (OA) is the Newport Harbor Yacht Club. .

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all Jr. Naples Sabot A, B, C1, C2, and C3 boats. Five boats will be required to entitle a class to its own start.
- 2.2 Skippers must be members in good standing with their respective yacht clubs and class associations to be eligible to sail in this event.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter online by completing the entry form and paying the entry fee at www.nhyc.org. The entry fee for this regatta is \$30 and includes a hat (if you register by October 1), snacks and trophies.
- 2.4 No entry will be accepted after 1700 hrs Saturday, October 26th.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5. RACING AREA AND COURSES

- 5.1 Racing will take place in the harbor north of the Main Dock of the Newport Harbor Yacht Club.
- 5.2 The courses for all classes will be windward - leeward type courses or any variation of a triangular or other course.

6. SCORING

- 6.1 Two (2) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 6.2 When five (4) or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

7. TROPHIES

- 7.1 Trophies for top finisher in each class will be given their trophy after racing on October 27th.
- 7.2 The Non-Calm Bowl, a perpetual trophy, will be awarded to the boat finishing first in the largest class.

8. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest
