2. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY, ENTRY FEE

2.1. The Series is open to junior sailors under the age of 19 and who have not yet entered college. To be eligible for the SCYYRA North Series Perpetual Trophy, participants must be members in good standing of a current SCYYRA organization.

2.2. A participant must be in Sabot A Fleet.

2.3. A participant must be eligible to enter each regatta under INSA Junior Class rules.

2.4. All participants in North Series regattas must be SCYYRA members in good standing. Lifetime membership is free and can be completed at <https://theclubspot.com/join/WiAmVdxMup/overview>.

2.5. All participants in North Series regattas must be registered for the 2025-2026 North Series. Entries must be submitted at <https://theclubspot.com/regatta/TFp8OKBrGJ> (for ease of entry please use the Chrome browser). An entry must also be completed for each individual regatta in accordance with the Notice of Race for each event.

2.6. A participant may enter the series at the first, second, or third scheduled regatta but no later than the close of registration at the third regatta.

2.7. There will be a \$10.00 SCYYRA Series Sanctioning Fee per regatta that will be added onto each regatta's entry fee. The entry fee includes Series trophies and Series participation souvenirs for each skipper. Series souvenirs are only guaranteed for Series competitors who have entered the Series by the close of registration for the second regatta.

3. CLASS MEMBERSHIP

3.1. North Series participants must be INSA Class members in good standing. INSA Class Membership information can be found at www.naples-sabot.org. Please contact Jerelyn Biehl at jerelyn@odmsail.com with INSA Class questions.

4. RULES

4.1. Each regatta will be governed by the RRS, the prescriptions of US SAILING, North Series Rules as published on the SCYYRA website, INSA Class rules, this Notice of Series, and the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions issued by each host club.

5. SCORING

5.1. Low point scoring system, Appendix A4 will apply.

5.2. Series scoring will be based on the official results of each regatta tabulated only against other North Series entrants.

5.3. There may be 20 or more races scheduled and sailed in the North Series.

5.4. Ties will be broken using RRS Appendix A. If a tie still exists, the winner shall be the yacht finishing ahead in the final race that the yachts in question both started.

5.5. Rule 44.3c is modified to say, "the number shall be the whole number nearest to 20% of the number of boats entered in the *individual North Series Regatta*."

5.6. Throw-out races will be incorporated into the series scoring with the following formulas:

- If 14-15 races are completed, there will be 1 throwout.
- If 16-17 races are completed, there will be 2 throwouts.
- If 18-19 races are completed, there will be 3 throwouts.
- If 20 or more races are completed, there will be 4 throwouts.

5.6. Only Sabot A Fleet races are eligible to be scored.

5.7. Sail number changes must be reported and approved by the North Series Chair (or representative) and reported to the race committee prior to the start of racing each day.
